RELINE IMPRESSION

THE
MAXILLARY
COMPLETE DENTURE

**BEFORE SPENDING THE TIME AND MONEY TO
RELIN A DENTURE (MAXILLARY OR
MANDIBULAR) MAKE SURE THE DENTURE IS
WORTH THE EFFORT**

1. DO A REMOUNT USE A CENTRAL BEARING POINT TO CHECK OCCLUSION
2. USE PHONETICS TO CHECK ANTERIOR OCCLUSION AND PROPER VERTICAL DIMENSION



UNDERCUTS
WILL
PREVENT A

IMPRESSION

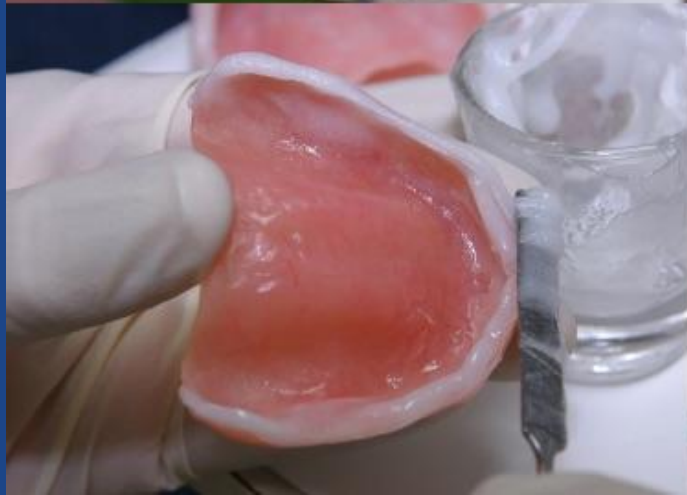

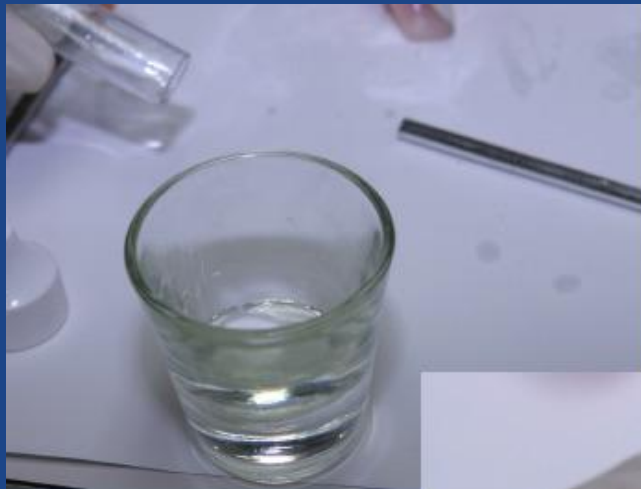
ADD MATERIAL TO THE
